

## Transfer Equivalency

The program at the University of Hartford (UH) discussions with the early education department faculty at Capital Community College (CCC) on transfer opportunities for Capital Community College students to the University of Hartford is complete. The University of Hartford and Capital Community College are founding members of the Hartford Consortium of Higher Education. Transfer opportunities to the University of Hartford would be beneficial for Capital Community College students given the University of Hartford offers a Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education and its location.

The two programs have discussed the following for students transferring from Capital Community College to the University of Hartford:

1. ECE 295 (the student teaching practicum at CCC) hours will be considered on a case-by-case basis for clinical hours.
2. Students from Capital Community would transfer 36 or 37 credits of general education and 24 to 27 credits in early childhood education to the Early Childhood Education program at UH. The course equivalencies in the chart below are what individuals typically use for transfer of 60 plus credits from a Community College. You are always welcome to request an audit as part of our admissions process if you have other courses
3. Transferring students would have to complete the final 30 credits of their BS at the UH.
4. Taking the PRAXIS CORE (formally Praxis I) academic skills assessment or the SAT (administered after 2005) is required for prospective teachers by the State of Connecticut.
