 SUMMARY OF COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Communication majors must complete the three core courses, one of two writing courses, plus the requirements of their chosen emphasis, plus 6 hours inside the school but outside their chosen emphasis. A grade point average of at least 2.25 in the major is required. (NOTE: A Bachelor of Arts degree in Communication requires a minimum of 120 credits.)

***COM 295 counts for CMM 406 only if taken for a grade of a C or better, and upon evaluation of the on-site experience. The student must submit documentation to the Director of the School of Communication for approval. The transfer admission department will coordinate and award approved credit. Communication internships are generally reserved for CMM majors who will have completed 60 credits by the beginning of the internship with an overall and in communication GPA of a 2.50 or better, though exceptions may be made. Typically you must work a minimum of 100 hours, submit 2 journals and one paper (or provide documentation of similar work) to the Director of the School of Communication.




