The student must submit documentation to the Director of the School of Communication for approval. The transfer admission department will coordinate and award approved credit. Communication internships are generally reserved for CMM majors who will have completed 60 credits by the beginning of the internship with an overall and in communication GPA of a 2.50 or better, though exceptions may be made. Typically you must work a minimum of 100 hours, submit two journals and one paper (or provide documentation of similar work) to the Director of the School of Communication.
