



## Articulation Agreement between Manchester Community College and the University of Hartford Paralegal Studies Program


The purpose of this agreement is to affect the smooth transfer of graduates of Manchester Community College (MCC) to the University of Hartford Paralegal Studies program. It applies to those courses required for the Bachelor of Science in Paralegal Studies degree. It provides specific information whereby students can transfer as juniors into the Paralegal Studies program.


### Stipulations of the Agreement

1. Students receiving an Associate's Degree with a 2.0 or higher cumulative grade point average will be guaranteed admission to the Paralegal Studies program provided they complete the required admission process, and subject to space availability in the program.
2. Only grades of "C" or higher will transfer.
3. MCC transfer students will be subject to all general education and other requirements for the Paralegal Studies degree. All requirements are in the current University of Hartford Bulletin.
4. The Paralegal Studies program encourages MCC students to complete their Associate's degree at MCC. This helps ensure readiness of MCC students to be successful after transfer. This agreement applies only to those who have completed their degree program.
5. This agreement will expire on June 30, 2013, at which point it will be reviewed by both parties. Any curriculum changes could necessitate review at an earlier date and potentially negate the remainder of the agreement.
6. The contact person at the University of Hartford will be the Director of the Paralegal Studies program and the contact person at MCC will be the Program Coordinator.
