

Articulation Agreement between Tunxis Community College and the Barney School of Business

The purpose of this agreement is to affect the smooth transfer of graduates of Tunxis Community College to the University Of Hartford Barney School Of Business. It applies to those courses required for the Associate of Science in Business Administration Transfer degree. It provides specific information whereby students can transfer as juniors into corresponding programs at the Barney School, and meet as many core curriculum requirements as possible.

Stipulations of the Agreement

1. Students receiving an Associates Degree with a 2.25 or higher cumulative grade point average will be guaranteed admission to the Barney School of Business provided they complete the required admission process, and subject to space availability at the Barney School.
2. Only grades of "C-" or higher will transfer for non-business courses.
3. Only grades of "C" or higher will transfer for business courses including economics and Quantitative classes.
4. Students taking BFN* 201: Principles of Finance must receive a grade of "B" or higher for this course to transfer as FIN 310.
5. Tunxis transfer students will be subject to all general education and other requirements of the Barney School of Business and University of Hartford. All requirements are in the current University of Hartford Bulletin.
6. The Barney School encourages Tunxis students to complete their Associates degree at Tunxis. This helps to ensure readiness of Tunxis students to be successful after transfer. This agreement applies only to those who have completed their degree program.
7. This agreement will expire on June 30, 2017 at which point it will be reviewed by both parties. Any curriculum changes could necessitate review at an earlier date and potentially negate the remainder of the agreement.
8. The contact person at the Barney School for this agreement will be the Associate Dean of Academics and at Tunxis will be the Business Administration Department Chair.

TRANSITIONING FROM TUNXIS COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO
BARNEY SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

To build on a strong relationship between the Barney School of Business and our partners in education, we have revisited the transfer process for graduates of Tunxis Community College. Tunxis Community College students enrolled in the Associate in Science Degree in Business Administration can transfer **all** of their courses towards their Bachelor of Science in Business Administration into the Barney School of Business according to the current articulation agreement.

Students in the Associates Degree program at Tunxis Community College must successfully complete specific courses to enter the Barney School of Business to pursue a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration. This transfer process provides Tunxis Community College students with the opportunity to fulfill the Barney School of Business degree requirements in the minimum number of credit hours. Joint advising will be available to Tunxis Community College students to foster a smooth transition into the Barney School of Business.

Automatic admission to the Barney School of Business is guaranteed for Tunxis Community College transfer students who:

1. complete their Associate in Science Degree in Accounting and Business Administration according to the Barney School of Business Transfer Articulation with an overall GPA of 2.25 out of 4.0
2. achieve a C (2.0) or higher in all business courses including economics and quantitative methods.
3. receive a C- or higher in courses eligible for transfer credit for non-business courses.

All students accepted into Barney School of Business are required to also complete QNT 230 Business Statistics **and** AUCS 130 The World of Business (**Barney School of Business course numbers**). Students that take BBG 101 with a C or above from Tunxis will transfer in credit for AUCS 130, The World of Business. Courses are **prerequisites** for all other Barney School of Business upper division business classes and must be taken as soon as possible. It may be taken at The Barney School of Business prior to transferring into the Bachelor's Program. Students must apply for admission to The University of Hartford, Barney School of Business upon entering Tunxis Community College for the Associate's Degree in Business Administration.
