Important Financial Aid Information

- Matriculated and registered students in good academic standing who have filed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA, available at www.fafsa.gov) may be eligible for federal financial aid (Direct Loans and/or Pell Grants). Part-time students are not eligible for institutional aid. The amount of aid for which you qualify depends on the total number of credits you have accumulated and your Expected Family Contribution (EFC), as determined by completion of the FAFSA.
- You must be matriculated in a degree or qualifying certificate program and enrolled in 3 or more credits per term to receive Pell. Students wishing to qualify for a Federal Direct Loan must be enrolled in 6 or more credits per semester, or one Saturday Term class per Saturday Term.
Adjustments to your registration may result in adjustments to your financial aid. Please contact the Office of Student Financial Assistance at 860-768-4296 if you have changes to your course schedule.
- A student may only receive the Federal Pell Grant for the equivalent of 12 semesters. Based on information from the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS), we will determine your remaining eligibility. Therefore, those who have used a Federal Pell Grant previously may have limited funds available.
- You must complete Entrance Loan Counseling and a Master Promissory Note at www.studentloans.gov for the Federal Direct Loan program. Additionally, you must maintain a credit load of at least 6 credits per term to prevent your loans from going into repayment.
